The first Summer Seuda Shlishit will take place next Shabbat afternoon 11th June following mincha at 8.50pm. The whole community is invited to participate in singing, Divrei Torah, and discussion about issues of communal interest.

RABBI PROF MICHAEL BROYDE AND RABBI CHAIM JACHTER

Alei Tzion is looking forward to hosting two prominent Modern-Orthodox halachic experts. On **Sunday 19th June, Rabbi Professor Michael Broyde** will be giving a shiur at 8.00 pm, entitled 'Peru U'revu, family planning and birth control'. Rabbi Broyde is a musmach of Yeshivah University, a dayan on the Beth Din of America and a professor of law at Emory University. On **Sunday 26th June, Rabbi Chaim Jachter** will be giving a breakfast shiur on the interaction between Technology and Halacha. Rabbi Jachter is an alumnus of Yeshivat Har Etzion, a member of the Halacha Committee of the RCA, and a dayan on the Beth Din of Elizabeth, New Jersey. Both Rabbi Broyde and Rabbi Jachter have written extensively on contemporary halachic issues. (Titles of the shiurim to be confirmed.) **Rabbi Broyde** will also be giving a shiur to **medical students and doctors** on **Sunday 19th June at 6.00 pm** entitled: 'Contemporary Medical Halacha'.
