On Shabbat Lech Lecha, 11th/12th October, Alei Tzion will be welcoming Rav Alex who will be joining us as a scholar-in-residence for Shabbat. Rav Alex will be speaking at the following times:

Dvar Torah at Kabbalat Shabbat - '**Why does the Torah not tell us Avraham's path to faith?**'
Shabbat morning keynote drasha - '**Avraham, Lot and the place of religion in Israel today.**'
Shabbat afternoon shiur - '**Ezra's revolution: How Ezra radically changed Judaism and what this means for us.**'
