Scholar-in-Residence – Rav Yuval Cherlow

We are delighted to be hosting Rav Yuval Cherlow as Scholar in Residence on Shabbat 15th December. Rav Cherlow is a modern Orthodox Rabbi and Posek. He is Rosh Yeshiva of Amit Orot in Ra'anana and one of the founders of Tzohar, an organisation which aims to bridge the gaps between religious and secular Jews in Israel. Since 2001 Rav Cherlow has answered more than 30,000 online Halachic questions. His book *Halacha c'beit Hillel* tackles the concept of halachic methodology. Rav Cherlow is a member of the ethics committee of the Israeli Ministry of Health, as well as the committee that allocates the government budget for new drugs. **This event is supported by the Chief Rabbi's Centre for Community Excellence.**
